Qaidah Nooraniyah



Qaida Nooraniyah is the first step for any child or beginner who wants to learn how to read the Quran correctly. This foundational course introduces the Arabic letters, their pronunciation, and how to form words and sentences from them using Tajweed rules — all in a simple and engaging way suitable for young learners.

Nazera Course

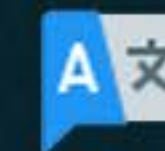

- Foundation for teaching others






Policies


Attendance policy for student

All students are expected to attend all lessons. Students should aim to be present 10 minutes before the lesson begins. Any student who arrives to the lesson after 10 minutes will be marked as 'late'. Our attendance target is 100%. However, if the attendance falls below 95% in any two consecutive weeks, students will have to go through our internal attendance improvements measures, which involves phone calls to parents, one-to-one online meetings with parents and even penalties if it is proven to be deliberate unauthorized absence. Excellent attendance will be rewarded by certificates, rewards, media coverage, and prizes.
